Commissioner Gardner opened the hearing at 4:04 p.m. and noted that this was a Public Hearing to discuss an application for a grant to construct a Sand and Salt shed for the Indian Township Passamaquoddy Tribe at Indian Township.

Bob Tyler, Agency Representative, stated that a description of the project has previously been given to the Commissioners. The proposed structure will be a 50' X 60' Sand and Salt Shed with a concrete foundation. \$200,000 of the \$250,000 project has been secured. Mr. Tyler requested the support of the Commissioners for this project.

Commissioner Gardner requested that the record reflects that the Commissioners offer their full support. He also stated that Mr. Tyler has done a good job meeting all the requirements of the CDBG program.
